"When I spoke to my mum and I told her that I will be visiting soon, the first thing she told me was that they didn't have a mattress to sleep on. She was worried where I would sleep!", said Clemy. When she arrived the mud hut was falling apart, there was hardly any furniture and the family members were all very thin. How would you as parent react if your daughter came home after 10 years and bought some matrasses and other house items for you?

"Knowing where I came from compared to where I am today and getting this opportunity to visit my home again is amazing. Now every time I see a person in need, I find myself shedding tears, just wanting to help them. All my life I was never confident but hearing from you has always given me the energy and reason to be confident. Thank you for loving me just the way I am and for being there for me and I love you so very much!"
